Viewer Installation Instructions

For DuctDesigner 3D Release 2012 v1

This document includes instructions for proper installation of the viewer application. QuickPen suggests that you review and follow the instructions to ensure that DuctDesigner 3D® Viewer functions properly after installation.

The instructions outlined in this document pertain to the Viewer for DuctDesigner 3D release 2012 v1. Please make sure that you are installing the viewer compatible with this version!

Preliminary Steps

Perform the following procedures before beginning the installation.

➤ **Verify Autodesk Application**

Before installing this version of the DuctDesigner 3D Viewer, verify that you have a compatible Autodesk® application installed.

➤ **Windows Applications**

Make sure all Microsoft Windows® based applications on the server are closed, including e-mail software, and virus protection software.

➤ **Uninstall Applications**

You must uninstall previous versions the DuctDesigner 3D Viewer (resident on the computer you are installing on) prior to installing the latest application.

Uninstall Previous Version of DuctDesigner 3D Viewer

1. Go to **Control Panel**.
2. Double-click on **Add or Remove Programs**.
3. Locate **DuctDesigner 3D Viewer** and then click on the **Remove** button.
4. In the InstallShield window, choose the **Remove** radio button. Click **Next**.
5. Choose **OK** to confirm.
6. Click **Finish**.

Download Procedures

1. Go to <http://www.quickpen.com/index.php/DD3D™-Viewers/> and then click **Viewers**.
2. Locate the *DuctDesigner 3D 2012 v1* heading. Read product notes and then click **Download** to copy the file to your computer.
3. In the File Download window, click **Save**.
4. In the **Save As** window, navigate to the location you want to use for the download, then click **Save**. Make note of where you saved the file.
5. When the download is complete, click **Close** the Download window. *Note:* Depending on your computer settings, the Download window may close automatically.

Installation Procedures

Do *not* install the DuctDesigner 3D Viewer on the same computer where the DuctDesigner application is located. Doing so will cause conflicts within the DuctDesigner 3D program.

To ensure proper behavior of the application, please follow all of the procedures as outlined in the next topics.

Downloaded File

1. Navigate to the location where you saved the downloaded file.
2. Double-click on **DuctDesigner3DViewer2012 v1** installation file.

Depending on your computer settings, you may see an *exe* file extension. Also, if you downloaded the file from QuickPen's website, you may receive a security warning message. The message is designed to protect your computer and can be ignored for the viewer installation. Click **Run**.

3. The Welcome to the InstallShield Wizard for DuctDesigner 3D Viewer screen displays. Click **Next**.
4. The License Agreement displays on-screen (*Software End User License Agreement*). Read the agreement. Choose the **I accept the terms in the License Agreement** checkbox. Click **Next**.

You must accept the terms of the agreement to proceed with the installation. If desired, you can click **Print** to obtain a hard copy of the agreement.

5. In the Complete the installation screen, click **Install**.
6. When the installation is complete, click **Finish**.
7. Close all remaining open installation files (if applicable).
